LECLERE PARK / TROUT FISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS

Section 18-41. Rules and Regulations for the use of LeClere Park Lake. "The rules and regulations for LeClere Park Lake shall be as follows":

- (1) Fishing will be permitted but must conform to the state fish and game laws. No trout lines, limb lines or bank lines will be permitted.
- (2) Ice-skating will be permitted in designated areas.
- (3) Watercraft will be permitted as follows:
 - a. Canoes eighteen (18) feet or less in length.
 - b. Rowboats and sailboats twelve (12) feet in length.
- (4) No other boats or watercraft over twelve (12) feet in length will be permitted.
- (5) Persons using canoes, boats or other watercraft are required to wear Coast Guard approved life jackets.
- (6) No trailers or transport canoes, boats, or other watercraft of any kind will be permitted in LeClere Park.
- (7) Electric trolling motors only will be permitted.
- (8) No swimming in the lake will be permitted.
- (9) Any other activities in regard to the use of said lake which are specifically set forth are hereby prohibited and unlawful and in violation of this section.
- (10) A special fishing license issued by the City of Coffeyville shall be purchased by persons wishing to fish in LeClere Park Lake between the dates of November 15 and April 30.
- (11) Any person desiring such license shall apply therefore to the City Clerk, or a designee of the City Clerk, exhibit his or her State License if State Law requires one and pay the required license fee. Each license shall be validated by the City Clerk, or City Clerk's designee, and the countersignature of the licensee and shall not be altered, assigned, or transferred.
- (12) The holder of any such fishing license shall upon demand, exhibit the same to any law enforcement officer.
- (13) The proceeds from the trout fishing licenses shall be used for the trout fishing program at LeClere Park Lake.
- (14) Fishing shall be restricted to that period of time each day between 7:00 a.m. and sunset. (Ordinance No. G-89-09)
- (15) It shall be unlawful to remove from LeClere Park Lake any catfish less than 16 inches in length or any bass less than 15 inches in length.

The daily creel limit for fish that can be taken from LeClere Park Lake per person shall be as follows:

Bass	2 per person per day
Catfish	2 per person per day
Sunfish, Crappie, Hybrid Bluegill	5 per person per day
Trout	2 per person per day
Wiper	1 per person per day

- (16) It shall be unlawful for any person fishing in LeClere Park Lake to exceed the daily creel limit.

Policy Resolution No. PR-89-01

Section 1. That the annual trout fishing permit fees at LeClere Park Lake shall be as follows:

Ages 15 years and under	\$ 5.00 per season
Ages 16 years to 60 years	\$10.00 per season
Ages 61 years and older	\$ 5.00 per season
3-day permit	\$ 3.00

Section 2. That approved vendors may collect an addition fee not to exceed \$0.50 for handling and processing of the permit.
